Treasurer's Report - Renee Mosi

- Completed refunds for Qayqat, Howay and NWSS for parent education events.
- Balance in gaming account is \$3,371.38
- Some additional funds will be used to pay for zoom account which is still outstanding. After cheques for Grade 12 NWSS scholarships are cashed balance will be \$3,368.83.
- 2022-23 budget will be presented next week at the award ceremony.
- The balance in checking account is \$5,003.86
- This will be Rene's last year for Treasurer's position.

Superintendent Report - District Update - Karim Hachlaf

- Thank you to Kathleen as past chair. Congratulations to new DPAC
- A year end letter will be sent out before end of June
- Look ahead
 - Aggresively pursuing Fraser River capital plan
 - We have a short term crunch over 3-5 years to manage base constraints without the new schools
 - Short term strategy must not be haphazard but must be thoughtful to recognize play space
 - Focus on before and after school childcare
- Summer Programs
 - Letter received from a parent with student who has diverse needs but also requires EA support
 - Parent was incorrectly told that EA support was not available.
 - This is not acceptable and not aligned with core values for inclusive learning
 - Bruce Cunnings has been directed will ensure appropriate supports

School Board Trustee Update - Gurveen Dhaliwhal

- Focus on site acquisition \$60M for 5 year capital plan
- Received green light for elementary school in fraser river zone
- Requested \$30M for fraster river zone, \$10M for PCAP, \$20M for a QMS expansion, As for \$1 for Hume Park expansion
- Second round of 5-year plan includes \$147M: \$65M for Fraser River moddle school, QMS expansion \$39M, and Hume Park Elemetary \$39M, included a Seismic Request \$509K for Hume Park
- Queen Elisabeth expansion planning in works
- There are some complexities in building due to floodplain, but not unexpected
- District was also approved for expanded Seamless childcare in Qayqyat.
- Will introduce new program Just Before in QMS for pre-kindergarten
- Met in person for first time at NWSS
